Lighting of the Paschal Candle

The light of the Paschal Candle symbolizes that the Light of Lights, Jesus Christ, who appeared to be extinguished on Good Friday, is alive. The candle will burn for the next 40 days to remind us that Jesus was present visibly for 40 days before he ascended into heaven. Following the Ascension celebration, the candle will be re-lighted at every Baptism, symbolizing the new life that comes to us through Baptism, and also at every funeral to remind us that God welcomes his children back to live forever with him.

[P] May the light of Christ, who is risen in glory from the dead, scatter all the darkness in our hearts.

[C] Light of God, brighten the darkness of our lives with the presence of your risen Son.
